

WILLFUL NEGLECT CHAIN INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING:

Bicycle products should be installed and serviced by a professional mechanic. Never modify your bicycle or accessories. Read and follow all product instructions and warnings including information on the manufacturer's website.

CHAIN I FNGTH

Chain tool required.

REPLACING A WORN CHAIN:

Measure the worn chain and shorten the new chain to the same length.

INITIAL ASSEMBLY:

Shorten the chain to the length specified by the derailleur manufacturer.

DERAILLEURS:


- Place the chain over the largest front chainwheel and largest rear sprocket. For rear suspension frames, position the rear suspension for the greatest chain length required
- Add two links or one link plus the connecting link

CONNECTING LINK INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Fit chain to the correct length; clean and lubricate bearing and pin.
- 2. Insert pin plate into both chain ends. FIG. 1
- 3. Bend both ends of the chain slightly towards you and click in the other end. FIG 2
- 4. Pull both ends of chain slightly away from you to lock chain in place. FIG.3
- 5. Check connectors for correct assembly. Opening: bend chain slightly and pull off the plate. FIG. 2
